



CA-004 : Amendment Restructure Bill

Below is the proposed amendment to the current UHD SGA Constitution that focuses on restructuring the process in which SGA constitutional amendments are made.

The purpose of this amendment is to alter the current constitutional amendment process which does not allow for administrations to effectively conduct business without having to endure a lengthy, drawn out process in order to make changes to the SGA constitution which affects the SGA's ability to perform at their highest level of capacity. We feel that this amendment will allow for a faster, smoother amendment process which will allow the SGA to deliver results to the student body in a much more effective and timely manner.

Below are the proposed changes to the language surrounding the amendment restructure process that shall be placed under, "**ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENTS**". in the UHD SGA constitution are as follows:

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENTS

Section One. Amendments.


This Constitution may be amended by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of those SGA members present and voting at a regular meeting of the SGA. The amendment must have been announced to the Student Body at least fifteen (15) days prior to the meeting in which it is considered. The notice shall include the complete text of the proposed amendment.

Section Two. Effective Date.

Amendments to this Constitution shall take effect at the adjournment of the meeting at which they are adopted unless otherwise provided.
