1. Call to Oder

- a. President Tatum, on behalf of Chief Justice Cubillos, set Quorum at six senators

- c. Senator Rios motioned to move the guest speakers to allow them to speak before talking about old business; Senator Garcia seconded the motion
- d. Senator Rios motioned to approve the agenda for this General Assembly; Senator Glenn seconded the motion
- e. President Tatum reset Quorum after the arrival of another Senator

2. Special Guests

- **a.** David Laundry, from the Financial Aid Department, spoke about issues students are having concerning their financial aid, including situations with lateness of awarding scholarships to students, and urged people to apply online at the earliest opportunities
- **b.** Chief Michael Benford, from the UHD Police Department, spoke about safety and listened students concerns; he will receive a list of concerns that students have concerning safety in campus, especially at night, by President Tatum. He also gave information concerning what to and not to do when a shooting situation were to occur in campus

3. Old Business

- a. Vote on Proposed Amendment CA-40-001
 - i. The amendment did not pass due to lack of students to vote. Senator Rios motioned to table the amendment until the next General Assembly; Senator Glenn seconded it
- b. Debrief Previous Events:
 - Speaker of the House Torres discussed about how Constitution Day went. He explained that
 624 people registered to vote during this event and the event had great turnout
 - ii. President Tatum said the Houston Youth Conference it was a successful event and students had a great time
 - iii. President Tatum explained that the organizers of the SGA University of Houston System Conference postponed the conference until further notice. Speaker of the House Torres revealed that the Conference would happen again on October 19th.
 - iv. President Tatum talked about Student Involvement Day, and talked about the creation of a QR code for volunteering opportunities while participating in Student Involvement Day.
 - v. Vice-president Lillie then talked about the Town Hall event that happened a few hours before the General Assembly, and explained that a lot of insight came from having the Town Hall, as well as numerous ideas to allow participation with other departments.
