- Mia Norfleet wanted to have a better system for organizations to connect. President Nieto expanded that many of the organizations do not know how to navigate the UHD org system and has held meeting with different departments to see how we can fix this issue.



- Meghana had more questions about the transition to Canvas. President Nieto said that the transition will happen in the summer and will be solidified the next school year. She still had some reservations about Canvas. Madame Secretary mentioned that she had used both Blackboard and Canvas and commented that Canvas is easier to navigate.
